

# INSTALLATION TIME 4 HOURS

#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

01. Remove the radiator cover. (14x pop clips)




**02.** Remove the front grille. (8x 10mm bolts) - once bolts are removed pull outward on the grille to unseat it from the grille support.



03. Remove the headlights. (8x 10mm bolts)



**04.** Remove the grille support. (4x 10mm bolts, 4x 13mm bolts, 6x tree clips, 1x electrical harness and electrical connector)



**05.** Remove the lower radiator ducting panel. (9x tree clips)

\*\*Note – front bumper removed to help show where the tree clips are located. Removal of the front bumper is not necessary.\*\*



**06.** Install the wedge spacers between the power steering cooler and the upper support bar. (2x 10mm bolts and 4x wedge spacers)






07. Install the MM1664-01 bracket between metal tube mount and the secondary radiator using the provided hardware. (1x HF6X1.0-20A)



**08.** Install the MM1664-02 bracket to the secondary radiator using the provided hardware. (2x HF6X1.0-20A)



**09.** Install the transmission cooler to brackets using the provided hardware. (4x HF6X1.0-14)

**10.** Remove stock fitting from stock liquid to liquid transmission cooler.




 Remove the metal transmission lines from the plastic line separator and plastic line fitting clip. Rearrange the lines to resemble the above image and then reconnect the metal transmission lines to the plastic line separator and plastic line fitting clip.



- Install the MM1513-15 fitting into the stock liquid-to-liquid transmission. Install the stock transmission cooler fitting into the MM1670 adapter.
  - \*\*Inspect the O-ring on the stock transmission cooler fitting. Replace it with the provided O-ring if it is damaged.\*\*



 Install the MM1662 line assembly and connect it to the MM1513-15 fitting, MM1670 adapter, and the transmission cooler using the provided worm gear clamps. (4x MM1325-2)

 Trim the lower radiator ducting panel as shown in the below images.



**15.** Trim the back of the grille support as shown in the below images.



- 16. Reinstall the lower radiator ducting panel.
- 17. Reinstall the grille support.
- Start the vehicle and check for leaks. Adjust the fluid level as needed. If no leaks are present, move on to step 19.
- 19. Reinstall the headlights.
- 20. Reinstall the grill.
- 21. Reinstall the radiator cover.

### **DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- > Do not dispose of any product as unsorted municipal waste.
  Use separate collection facilities. Contact your local authority for information regarding the collection systems available.
- > Never improperly dispose of any coolant, oil, or other chemicals.



#### WARRANTY INFORMATION

- > All claims must be accompanied with a picture of the Mishimoto product showing the issue for which the claim is being submitted.
- Mishimoto asks that the customer inspect their purchased item for any damage immediately upon arrival.
- Any product deemed dead on arrival (DOA) must be claimed within 14 business days of delivery. Claims outside of this time frame will not be covered under the Mishimoto Lifetime Warranty.
- This warranty does not include payment and/or reimbursement of the cost of labor in connection with the removal of any product returned pursuant to the warranty policy or in connection with the installation of any replacement items provided under the warranty policy.
- > Mishimoto has the right to refuse a claim at any time.
