

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 01. Read all important safety information prior to installing our products.
- 02. Remove the snorkel from the intake. (2x 8mm bolts)



- 03. Disconnect the air intake sensor and condenser sensor.
- 04. Undo the clips holding the harness to the airbox. (2x tree-clips)



05. Separate the quick-disconnect by pulling the yellow tab out.

06. Separate the coolant line from the intake tube.



07. Loosen the clamps on either end of the intake tube. (2x worm gear clamps)



- 08. Remove the intake tube.
- 09. Remove the bolts holding the airbox. (2x 8mm bolts)



Lift the airbox and push toward the engine to disengage the rubber grommet.

11. Using a pick tool, lift the tab on the sensor and rotate counterclockwise.



- 12. Carefully push the sensor out from the inside.
- 13. Set the sensor into the Mishimoto intake tube, align the tabs, and turn clockwise.



14. Remove the two inserts and grommets from the stock airbox.



15. Insert the rubber grommets into the Mishimoto airbox.



16. Place the inserts within the grommets.



- 17. Remove the side grommet from the stock airbox.
- **18.** Assemble the peg found in your kit by placing the spring washer on the bolt and place the bolt within the peg.



Install the assembled peg into the Mishimoto airbox. (5mm Allen key)



20. Install the side grommet over the peg.



- 21. Install the airbox by aligning the side peg first, then the bolt holes.
- **22.** Insert the wiring clip into the hole in the airbox, then run the wiring harness below the intake.



23. Bolt down the Mishimoto airbox. (2x 8mm bolts)




24. Bolt down the Mishimoto intake duct. (2x 8mm bolts)



25. Slide the intake grommet over the intake tube with the words facing out.



26. Slide the air filter over the intake tube. (1x worm gear clamp)




27. Place the smaller end of the intake coupler over the intake.




28. Slide the intake filter in first, and then rotate it to align with the coupler.



29. Once aligned, push the rubber grommet into place.







- **31.** Tighten the clamps on either end of the intake coupler. [2x worm gear clamps]
- 32. Reconnect the intake and condenser sensors.



33. Wrap and secure the provided zip tie around the blow-off valve hose. Now attach this zip tie to the tree-clip zip tie that is already mounted on the coolant hose. The tree clip on the stock zip tie will push into the hole on the provided zip tie.
