




\*Note: To avoid potential injury, wait for the vehicle to completely cool off before working in the engine bay.

### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


1. Loosen the hose clamp (5.5mm socket). Release the airbox clip.



2. Unplug the electrical connector for the MAF sensor. Release the other airbox clip. Pull the loose end of the hose off the intake pipe then, remove the airbox lid and hose from the vehicle.




3. Remove the 4x bolts (10mm socket) and pop clip then, remove the lower half of the airbox from the vehicle.



4. Remove the 2x bolts (10mm socket) then, remove the bracket from the vehicle.



5. Remove the rubber grommet from the bottom half of the stock airbox and install it into the Mishimoto airbox.



6. Remove the 2 screws (Phillips screwdriver) fastening the MAF sensor to the stock airbox lid then remove the MAF sensor from the housing.




7. Install the MAF sensor into the Mishimoto MAF housing as shown using the supplied M4 hardware and tighten the screws (2.5mm hex key).



8. Install the grommet onto the MAF housing as shown, followed by the filter. Ensure they are pushed all the way up against the flange on the MAF housing then, tighten the hose clamp on the filter (8mm socket).




9. Install the Mishimoto airbox into the vehicle as shown and fasten using the 2x bolts (10mm) removed in step 4.




10. Ensure the rubber grommet is pushed onto the lower mounting peg.




11. Install the MAF housing, filter, and grommet assembly into the airbox as shown, making sure the airbox is seated in the groove on the grommet all the way around the perimeter.



12. Remove the 90-degree outer housing from the MAF sensor plug.



13. Plug the MAF sensor connector back in then, install the coupler as shown and fasten using the 2x supplied worm gear clamps (7mm socket).



This concludes the installation.
